

Scholarship Application Form 2019-20



Dayley Dance Academy NW makes every effort to award financial aid when circumstances require it. The majority of resources available are dedicated to families with financial need, with a limited allocation based on merit. DDANW Board of Directors reviews each application in confidence and makes award decisions based on the information provided in this application.

All families are strongly encouraged to check their local community agencies for scholarships in addition to those that may be provided by DDANW. Many organizations offer scholarships for performing arts education to qualified individuals. Our office can provide a template letter to share with community agencies upon request.

All scholarship applications require the following items:

1. Parent/Guardian 2018 US Tax Form 1040 - first page showing Adjusted Gross Income (AGI)
2. Essay (legible) from youth stating what they can bring to DDANW as a potential scholarship recipient and why they are seeking a scholarship
3. Two Referrals from outside sources such as teachers, employers, mentors, etc. (not family)
4. Parent/Child Interview with DDANW Executive Director – scheduled with the office 360-210-5981

Scholarship decisions cannot be made without the required information. Scholarships are awarded based on income per year and living residents in household. Other factors taken into consideration are referrals, youth determination and dedication to dance as a study.

At the end of the application process, if a scholarship is awarded, there will be work study duties given to recipient with a contractual agreement regarding expectations and parameters to be met for maintaining scholarship status. Work study, expectations and parameters will be based on amount of award.

- Deadline for Summer 2019 and Fall 2019-20 season is June 1st, 2019
- Summer 2019 scholarships are eligible for weekly classes only and dependent upon enrollment.
- If scholarship is awarded, any additional fees that the student will foreseeably incur over the season must be paid in advance incremental payments from June – Nov of 2019. (Costume, recital, etc.)
